

The intellectual property law landscape is in constant flux, particularly with the rise of Al, blockchain, and the new Unified Patent Court in Europe. In this era of a global financial and social economy, no lawyer can afford to avoid having at least a basic working knowledge of intellectual property.

These specialized areas of the law show up both in expected situations, such as the sale of business assets where the brand name or product name is involved, and in unexpected situations, such as the simple employment contract where companies are more frequently requiring employees to sign away all rights to any invention as part of their employment, in divorces where one spouse has rights in certain technology, copyrights, or even patents, or in estates when figuring out how to deal with the most valuable types of intangible property.

The unwary attorneys may overlook important and far-reaching consequences to their clients, or in fact may not even be aware they are being overlooked until it is too late.
